The Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles announces the temporary suspension of the DMV Driver Licensing Services located in Plattsmouth, Cass County beginning Monday, June 13, 2011. Services will resume on August 18, 2011. There will be no DMV Examiners available during this time. The suspension of service is necessary to assist with the completion of the Cass County Courthouse renovation.

“The Department has worked closely with the Cass County Board of Commissioners in an attempt to relocate our driver licensing services during the courthouse renovation,” said Beverly Neth, Director, Department of Motor Vehicles. “Much to everyone’s disappointment, none of the three facilities we investigated met our needs.”

Jim Peterson, Chairperson of the Cass County Board of Commissioners conveys his appreciation to the Department of Motor Vehicles and the citizens of Cass County for their patience during the installation of the fire sprinkler system. These changes are necessary for the safety of the courthouse employees as well as visiting citizens.

“The Department will resume all driver licensing services in Cass County as soon as possible, said Neth. “In the meantime, I encourage those who are renewing to go to our website www.clickdmv.ne.gov to access our on-line driver license renewal process. It is an easy and quick process that can be used by many people.”

The Cass County Treasurer's Office will remain open to process duplicate and replacement non-commercial driver licenses and State ID Cards. All motor vehicle services will be available as well.

All driver-licensing services are scheduled to resume on August 18, 2011.
