**DMV Driver License Office Wait Times Now Available Online**

***DMV Deploys timesaving technology in 3 most-populous counties***

Lincoln NE – The Department of Motor Vehicles today unveiled its new online queuing system. Applicants in Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy Counties for driver license and State ID Card documents can now access DMV Driver Licensing Office expected wait times online, allowing customers to best plan their visits and save time by planning.

Beverly Neth, Department of Motor Vehicles Director said, “This system is a fantastic tool to help applicants save time. It demonstrates our continued commitment to expanding our online services.”

The online system allows applicants for the three most populated counties in the state to see if there is a wait time over 30 minutes.

Neth reminds all Nebraskans to check the CLICKDMV website before getting into their cars.

“For many transactions, the DMV is always open -- 24 hours a day, seven days a week -- holidays included. Any day, any time, renew your vehicle registration or driver license, apply for a duplicate driver license, request a copy of your driving record, purchase specialty plates, and more. The DMV has 18 transactions available online. “
