STATE DRIVER LICENSE OFFICES WILL BE CLOSED April 7 – 10

LINCOLN – Rhonda Lahm, Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles announced today the temporary closing of all of the state’s 97 driver license locations from April 7 through April 10, 2014. Offices will be open for normal Friday business hours on April 11, 2014. The DMV driver license staff will be attending centralized statewide training.

“We do recognize these office closings may temporarily inconvenience some of our customers; however, training on driver license security issues, changes to commercial motor vehicle skills tests, improved customer service, and computer usage is essential,” Lahm said. “The ability for examiners to participate in a hands-on training environment is critical to administering tests proficiently.”

The Department of Motor Vehicles has a large suite of online services which are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week – holidays included. Qualified individuals can obtain permits, licenses and state identification cards online at www.CLICKDMV.ne.gov.

“Individuals who are planning to get a new driver’s permit, license, or state identification card; and are not eligible to use the online services are encouraged to plan ahead and mark these closing dates on their calendars,” said Sara O’Rourke, Driver License Administrator.

“Individuals renewing their licenses can do so up to 90 days prior to the expiration date.”
