**STOLEN VEHICLES RECOVERED**

**(OMAHA, NE)** - An Omaha man was arrested and vehicles seized as part of an investigation into stolen vehicles and fraudulent certificate of title transactions.

The Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles Fraud Unit in conjunction with the Nebraska State Patrol and the Omaha Police Department executed search warrants at four homes in Omaha the morning of March 13, 2014. The warrant service followed a nearly six-month long and ongoing investigation into the possession and sale of stolen vehicles.

"We are glad to be able to identify and stop criminal activity which victimizes citizens in Nebraska," said Rhonda Lahm, Director of the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles. "The combined efforts of multiple agencies were essential to the success of this ongoing investigation." Further assistance was received by an agent from the National Insurance Crime Bureau.

A total of six vehicles were seized in addition to vehicle parts and related items. As a result of serving the warrants, additional charges are pending.

The investigation continues.
